Open call to current law students! Looking for a rewarding and dynamic legal internship this summer? Interested in reforming the criminal legal system and networking with others working in this space? Then read on to learn more about the Prosecutors Alliance and our paid summer internship program!

Qualifications:

The internship is open to students enrolled at U.S. law schools who will have completed at least one year of law school before the summer of 2026.

Excellent research skills, including conducting internet and legal research.

Excellent communication skills, both verbal and in writing.

Attention to detail, excellent organizing and time-management skills.

Proficiency in Google Workspace.

The ability to be self-directed and to have the initiative and drive to see projects through to completion.

A passion for criminal justice reform, social justice and civil rights.

A commitment to the mission of the Prosecutors Alliance.

Time Commitment:

A Summer internship requires a part-time (20 hours/week) or full-time (35 hours/week) commitment. The time commitment is negotiable.

Internship Duration: Part-time internships are for a 12 week period and full time internships are for a 10 week period. The internship start and end dates are negotiable/flexible.

Responsibilities:

Interns interested in criminal justice reform will gain invaluable experience working with a small team on a wide variety of policy and legal issues

Conducting legal and policy research

Writing assignments in areas of policy, communications, legislative analysis, and public education

Help coordinate events and programming for PAC law school chapters; conduct outreach to law schools and recruit law students to help form new PAC law school chapters

Other projects as assigned

Benefits:
